### PREPARATION:

- Inspect all components of the PSD prior to use. If any defects or abnormalities are observed, DO NOT use the PSD, return it to an Authorized Oceanic Dealer for inspection.
- Prior to use, ensure that the PSD is completely deflated and secured inside the Pouch located on the left pocket of the BC.

### USE as a SIGNAL DEVICE:

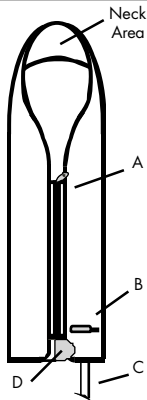
- Open the Velcro Flap and remove the PSD from the Pouch.
- Unroll the Tube and inflate it using the Oral Inflation Valve.
- Extend the Tube Straight up above the surface of the water.

### USE as a FLOTATION DEVICE:

- Open the Velcro Flap and remove the PSD from the Pouch.
- Unroll the Tube and inflate it using the Oral Inflation Valve.
- Connect the edges of the Tube together with the Zipper.
- Secure the Velcro Closure.
- Place the Tube over your head.
- Wrap the Web Strap around your waist and secure the Buckle.

### CARE and MAINTENANCE:

- Remove the PSD from the Pouch.
- Rinse with fresh water.
- Inspect to ensure removal of any debris.
- Allow it to air dry.
- Store in a cool dry location out of direct hot sunlight or high heat.



#### Components

(configured as a Flotation Device)

- A. Zipper
- B. Oral Inflator
- C. Strap/Buckle
- D. Velcro Closure
